## - Work Stream Update:

- **Legal:** Susan reports that she and Sally have read of the Levittown Case, which has a similar situation to our town and school. They believe not a lot can be done from a legal standpoint. Also, that we should look into if we can overturn the decisions that were made in the past.
- Assessments/Taxes- Amanda has generated a lot of information on the Beachfront Associations from the Assessor's office. The Committee has been looking over that data. Peter also has been generating Graphs and Tables, lots of Data! There was also a discussion about multiyear averaging and the reassessment process.
- Communications- Linda will be working on setting up a time for the Committee
  to get a tour of the Ticonderoga High School. Sandy has been speaking to locals
