The Board approved a Variance application for: BROWN (43.13-1-43) 17 Anchor Way (TR1) VAR 09-14 for a greater than 25% increase to a nonconforming house with the condition that a stormwater plan be submitted, approved and implemented by the Town ZEO.

They also deemed an application complete for a Variance for CAPE COD VILLAGE CLUB, INC. (43.13-1-31) NYS Rte. 9N (TR1) VAR 10-14 for a nonconforming subdivision. A site visit and a hearing was scheduled.
